SHOW JUMPING

This is a Team and Individual competition.

Each Team of 4 are required to jump 2 rounds.

If, however, more than 2 team members are eliminated in the first round, the entire team will be eliminated and cannot jump in the second round. Team members may still complete the next round but as an individual competitor.

A jump off will only be required if, after both rounds, 2 or more teams are on the same score. In this case, the tied teams only will be required to complete a jump off course.

Style Jumping - Riders jump one round of 7 obstacles, to include a style or narrow fence and a double, and are judged on the style of their riding. The maximum fence height will be 85cm.

Riders must salute the judge when entering the arena, and then canter on both reins until the signal to start is given; during this time, they will be judged for style on the flat.

When jumping, the rider is judged on their position on take-off, in the air, on landing and in the following stride at each fence. After the round is complete, the rider must canter until the signal to finish is given; during this time, they will again be judged for style on the flat.
