## **RIDER INFORMATION**

### **Entry Fee**

<b>Members</b>	<b>£8.50 per class</b>
<b>Non Members</b>	<b>£13.00 per class</b>

An additional **£1.00** per rider payable for First Aid Cover.

*(£3.00 at Summer Show on 16<sup>th</sup> August only, as Paramedic cover available)*

You may enter Section A **Or** Section B of each test, but **not** both on the same horse.

No horse or pony to compete in more than 3 classes at any evening show.

No horse with more than 100 BD points may compete in ANY class.

### **Section R - Restricted**

Restricted to horse/rider combinations not to have won more than **15** RFRD dressage points if a member or not to have come 1st in **any** dressage test if a non-member. Horses with BD points are **not** permitted to compete in Section A. Members points summary is available on the website

**Section O – Open** to any horse with less than 100 BD points.

### **BD Walk & Trot Test**

- bona-fide beginners (riders) never to have been placed in a dressage test **or**
- riders on young horses where the combination has not been placed in a dressage competition.
- No RFRD points will be awarded in this class
- Once any horse/rider combination wins the class on 2 occasions, they will be required to ride HC for any further entry.

All tests are British Dressage including Walk & Trot Tests. ***Please note:*** the riding club do not provide the tests - copies can be purchased from the BHS.

**RFRC Points** Awarded to RFRC members only in all classes except W&T tests.

<b><i>1<sup>st</sup> highest gets</i></b>	<b><i>4 points,</i></b>
<b><i>2nd highest gets</i></b>	<b><i>3 points,</i></b>
<b><i>3rd highest gets</i></b>	<b><i>2 points,</i></b>
<b><i>4th highest gets</i></b>	<b><i>1 point.</i></b>

### **Trophies**

**Money Maker** - awarded to the junior RFRC member with the most points gained in RFRC dressage classes this year

**Connaught Ranger** - awarded to the senior RFRC member with the most points gained in RFRC Open Dressage classes this year

**Restricted Cup** - awarded to the senior RFRC member with the most points gained in RFRC Open Dressage classes this year

### **DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED**

#### **Horse/Pony**

Need not be plaited, but should be clean and tidy.

No boots or bandages

BD tack permitted only.

#### **Rider**

Jodhpurs or breeches - Cream, white, canary or beige

***NO OTHER COLOURS***

Jacket with shirt & tie, or stock, or RFRC sweatshirt.

Gloves must be worn, preferably dark in colour.

Long rubber/leather riding boots, or jodhpur boots with matching plain coloured chaps or gaiters.

Hats must be fastened at all times when mounted.

Hair must not hang below collar.

# CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATION

- Open to RFRC members **only**
- Qualifier to take place on Saturday October 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Qualify for Prelim and Novice at Restricted and Open level, or Elementary level.
- Member scores of 58% or over will qualify
- You must enter the Championship at the highest level that you have qualified
- Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> plus prizes in kind

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1) It is a condition of entry that each competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
- 2) The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of, or to, any horse, rider, spectator or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 3) No entry is accepted without the correct remittance.
- 4) In case of adverse weather it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed.
- 5) The organisers reserve the right to refuse or refund entries.
- 6) Any objection must be lodged at the secretary's box within 15 minutes of the end of the class with a deposit of £10. The panel's decision is final. If the objection is over-ruled, the deposit is not refundable.
- 7) All competitors **MUST**, when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN1384 minimum standard fitted with a three point harness. Penalty for not obeying this rule is elimination. Hair must not hang below collar.
- 8) No galloping is allowed outside the ring(s).
- 9) We advise wearing a back protector to Level 3 at all times when mounted at all shows and events, although this is not compulsory.
- 10) All **DOGS** must be kept on a lead and under control at **ALL TIMES** unless securely left inside vehicles. *Remember dogs will die if left in hot cars*
- 11) In the event of cancellation by RFRC, 80% of entry fee will be refunded.
- 12) No horse with more than 100 BD points may enter ANY dressage class.
- 13) No refunds without producing either Doctor or Vet Certificate.
- 14) Photographer Attending – if you do not wish your child to be photographed, please notify Secretary upon Entry.
- 15) Please **DO NOT** muck out your lorry/trailer onto showground, penalty for doing so is **£10**
