TIMES Class 1 will start at 9.30am. Individual times will be allocated and available on Friday 25th September from the website, **www.rfrc.org**, and at the course walk.

COURSE The course will be available for inspection from 2pm to 5pm Saturday 25th September.

In the case of inclement weather, it is the rider's responsibility to phone the entry secretary or check the website to check if the show has been cancelled.

Chin straps and back protectors must be worn at ALL times when mounted. Medical armbands are recommended for all XC and Hunter Trials. Hats must NOT have fixed peaks and hair must be worn above the collar.

QUALIFIER FOR THE FINALS OF

THE SOUTH ESSEX INSURANCE BROKERS BHS CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010

This event is a qualifier for the Finals of the South Essex Insurance Brokers BHS Cross Country Championships 2010.

In the nominated qualifying classes, the TWO highest placed riders (or 2 highest placed Pairs) who are BHS Gold Member ON THE DAY OF THE QUALIFIER will qualify for the Final.

In the event of a combination of horse/pony and rider already having qualified, the qualification will pass down to the next eligible competitor.

You must provide the Entries Secretary with your BHS membership number when you enter the qualifier but we recommend you also carry your membership card on the day.

Non-members may enter qualifying classes but will not be eligible to qualify. Horses registered for the British Eventing Horse Trials in 2009 are NOT eligible to qualify for the Finals. (BE Day Tickets are acceptable).

Rules at qualifiers may differ from those at the Finals. Classes at the Finals will be Novice and Pairs (both max 2'9"), and Open (max 3' 3").

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) It is a condition of entry that each competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
- 2) The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of or to any horse, rider, spectator or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 3) No entry is accepted without the correct remittance.
- 4) In case of adverse weather it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed.
- 5) Any competitor jumping any fence outside the jumping rings other than the allocated practice fence will be disqualified.
- 6) The organisers reserve the right to refuse or refund entries.
- 7) Any objection must be lodged at the secretary's box within 15 minutes of the end of the class with a deposit of £10. The panel's decision is final. If the objection is over-ruled, the deposit is not refundable.
- 8) All competitors **MUST**, when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN1384 minimum standard fitted with a three point harness. Hats must not have fixed peaks. Penalty for not obeying this rule is elimination. Hair must not reach the collar.
- 9) No galloping is allowed outside the ring(s).
- 10) Competitors eliminated or retiring must leave the course at a walk and may not jump after retiring.
- 11) **IN CROSS COUNTRY/HUNTER TRIAL EVENTS, ALL COMPETITORS MUST WEAR BACK PROTECTORS WHILE COMPETING.**
- 12) All **DOGS** must be kept on leads at **ALL TIMES** unless securely left inside vehicles. Dogs must be kept under control at all times.
Remember dogs will die if left in hot cars
- 13) In the event of cancellation by RFRC, 80% of entry fee will be refunded.
- 14) No refunds will be given without the production of a letter from your vet or GP
- 15) Photographer attending, if you do not wish your child to be photographed, please notify the Secretary upon entry.
- 16) Stopwatches or mobile phones, are **not permitted** on the course.
