

## RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. It is a condition of entry that each entry competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
2. The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of or to any horse, rider, spectator or any persons or property whatsoever.
3. No entry will be accepted without correct remittance.
4. In case of adverse weather conditions it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed.
5. Any competitor jumping any fence outside the jumping rings other than the allocated practice fence will be disqualified.
6. The organisers reserve the right to refund or refuse entries.
7. Any objection must be lodged with the secretary within 15 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £25. The panels decision is final. If the objection is upheld the deposit is refundable.
8. All competitors MUST when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN standard fitted with a three point harness.
9. No galloping outside the rings.
10. Competitors eliminated must leave the ring at walk. No remounting.
11. We advise wearing body protectors at all times when mounted at all shows and events, although this is not compulsory.
12. All DOGS must be kept on a lead and under control at ALL TIMES, unless securely left in vehicle. *Remember dogs may die if left in hot cars.*
13. In the event of cancellation, RFRC will refund 80% of entry fee.
14. No horse with more than 100 BD points may enter dressage class.
15. No refunds without producing either a Doctor or Vet certificate.
16. **PHOTOGRAPHER ATTENDING** – if you do not wish your child to be photographed please inform secretary upon entry.
17. Riders age as on day of show.

***Please DO NOT muck out your lorry or trailer onto the Showground. The penalty for doing so is £10***

## **RING 1 – SHOWING**

(Promptly at 9.15am)

Class 1. Best Turned Out – Open

Class 2. Lead Rein – ponies not to exceed 12 hh. To be shown plaited or unplaited. Riders to be 8 yrs & under. Class may be split if sufficient entries. Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 3. First Ridden – ponies not to exceed 12.2 hh. To be shown plaited or unplaited. Riders to be 11 yrs & under. Class may be split if sufficient entries. Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 4. Young Handler. Handler 12 yrs or under. *To be judged on ability & style of handler.*

**CHAMPIONSHIP** Open to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prizewinners in classes 1-4. Champion & Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship.

Class 5. Pony Club Pony. Ponies not to exceed 13.2 hh. *To be judged on suitability as a p.c. pony. Competitors will be required to jump a small fence and give an individual show. Not to be judged on conformation.*

Class 6. Pony Club Pony. Ponies not to exceed 15 hh. *To be judged on suitability as a pc pony, you will be required to jump a small fence and give an individual show. Not to be judged on conformation.*

Class 7. Riding Club Horse. Horses over 15hh. *To be judged on suitability as a r.c. horse, you will be required to jump a small fence and give an individual show. Not to be judged on confirmation.*

Class 8. Ridden Mountain & Moorland Pony. Rider any age. Open to registered and unregistered ponies. Class may be split if sufficient entries.

**CHAMPIONSHIP** - Open to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in classes 5-8. Champion & Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship.

## **RING 4 - SHOW JUMPING**

**(Promptly at 10.00am)**

Class 28.	2'0"	Approx 65cm	Open
Class 29.	2' 3"	Approx 70cm	Open
Class 30.	2'6"	Approx 75cm	Open
Class 31.	2'9"	Approx 85 cm	Open
Class 32.	3'3"	Approx 100cm	Open

*Classes 28 – 32 will run as a 2-phase competition, i.e. Jump the course and, if clear, continue on to do a timed jump-off course.*

Classes will be split between horses and ponies if sufficient entries.

## **MEMBERS CHAMPIONSHIP**

RFRC members in showing classes should wear an armband. The highest placed member in each class will be awarded a special rosette. Winners of these rosettes are eligible for the Members Championship.

The Members Champion will be awarded the Coombewood Trophy at the AGM.

The Members Champion and Reserve will receive a Sash and be eligible for the Supreme of Show Championship

## **SUPREME OF SHOW CHAMPIONSHIP**

The Supreme of Show Championship is open to all Champions and Reserves. To be held in Ring 2 at the end of the day and to be judged by Mrs A Doughty.

## **RING 2 – SHOWING**

**(Promptly at 9.15am)**

Class 9. Youngstock. In-Hand. Animals 1, 2, 3 years old.

Class 10. Best Condition. In-Hand. Open.

Class 11. Veteran. In-Hand. Animals 15 years or over.

Class 12. Mountain and Moorland. In-Hand. Class may be split into youngstock & 4 years and over if sufficient entries.

Class 13. Coloured horse/pony. In-Hand. Piebald & Skewbald.

Class 14. Odd & Unusual Coloured horse/pony In-Hand. Spotted, Roan, Dun, Palomino etc.

**CHAMPIONSHIP** Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners in Classes 9-14. Champion and Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship.

## **RING 2 – SHOWING FUN CLASSES**

**(To follow on)**

Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 15. Best Mane.

Class 16. Best Tail.

Class 17. Prettiest Mane.

Class 18. Handsomest Gelding.

Class 19. Thelwell Pony.

Class 20. Horse/Pony the Judge would most like to take home.

## RING 3 – SHOWING

(Promptly at 9.15am)

Class 21. Competition Horse/Pony. Horse/Pony 4yrs old and over. Rider to be an appropriate size for the animal which they ride.

*Riders will enter the ring individually and perform an individual show to include the following movements, Halt, Walk on a long rein, 3 loop trot serpentine, extended trot on the diagonal, 3 loop canter serpentine with change of lead, extended canter on the diagonal. Individual show not to exceed 2 minutes.*

Class 22. Ridden Veteran. Horse/Pony 18 years and over.

Class 23. Riding Horse. Horses 15hh or over.

Class 24. Ridden Hunter.

Class 25. Ridden Cob.

Class 26. Ridden Coloured. Skewbald, Piebald, Spotted, Roan, Dun, Palomino etc.

Class 27. Ridden pony. Under 15 hh.

**CHAMPIONSHIP** - Open to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners for Classes 21-27. Championship and Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship.

## RING 3 – WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

(To follow on)

Class 28. Nursery Stakes. Ponies not to exceed 13.hh. Rider 12 years and under. Fences not to exceed 1' 9".

Class 29. Working Hunter Pony. Ponies not to exceed 15.hh. Rider to be an appropriate size for the animal which they ride. Fences not to exceed 2' 3".

Class 30. Working Hunter. Horses exceeding 15 hh. Riders any age. Fences not to exceed 2' 9".

**CHAMPIONSHIP** - Open to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners for Classes 28-30. Championship and Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship.

## DRESSAGE

Class D1R	Preliminary 7 (2002)	Restricted/Open
Class D1O	Preliminary 18 (2002)	Restricted/Open

Class D2R	Novice 20 (2007)	Restricted/Open
Class D2O	Novice 26 (2006)	Restricted/Open

You may enter the Restricted **OR** Open Section of each test. You may **NOT** enter both sections on the same horse.

- a) No horse or pony with more than 100 BD points may compete in **ANY** class.
- b) No horse or pony with **ANY** BD points may compete in a **RESTRICTED** class.

Restricted classes are open to horse/rider combinations not to have won more than 15 RFRC dressage points if a RFRC member, or not to have come 1<sup>st</sup> in **ANY** dressage test if a non-member.

- Member scores of 58% or over will qualify
- You must enter the Qualifier at the highest level you have qualified
- Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> plus prizes in kind
