Evening Show Jumping

All classes will run as a single phase competition. This means that a timed section will be included in the first round, this should be completed in all cases unless elimination has been called.

Sunday Show Jumping

A 'jump off' round against the clock will be required following the completion of all first rounds, as normal. If there is insufficient time due to a high number of entries, a 2-phase type system will be used.

NB. The organiser reserves the right to change the above jumping methods depending on entry numbers.

NOVICE - RING ONE

**10am prompt start Sundays
6pm prompt start Wednesdays**

Class 1	65cm (approx 2'0")
Class 2	70cm (approx 2'3")
Class 3	75cm (approx 2'6")
Class 4	85cm (approx 2'9") (no points in this class)

Novice Classes are open to horse/rider combinations not to have won more than 15 RFRC show jumping points if an RFRC member, or not to have come 1st or 2nd in any show jumping class if a non-member.

SHOW JUMPING CHAMPIONSHIP

Rockingham Forest RC have organised a show jumping championship, to take place on 15th August 2010.

- Championship Schedule available with full details
- Entry on the day
- There is no qualification criteria
- Championship classes are open to RFRC members only
- There will be a Novice Championship and an Intermediate Championship
- Championship classes include the completion of 2 show jumping rounds.
- Both rounds have a time allowed, detailed on the day, if eliminated in the first round the rider will not be eligible to complete the second round.
- The second round will include a timed section, specified on the day.
- The winner of the class will be the best first round and the best second round with the fastest timed section
- Rosettes 1st – 10th and sashes for the champions

INFORMATION FOR ENTRANTS

DRESSCODE

Jodhpurs or breeches - cream, white, canary or beige.

NO OTHER COLOURS

Jacket with shirt and tie or stock, or RFRC sweatshirt.

Long rubber or leather riding boots, or jodhpur boots with matching colour gaiters or chaps.

Hats must be fastened at all times whilst mounted.

Hair must not hang below collar.

MEMBER AWARDS

RFRC members will gain points towards show jumping trophies awarded at the AGM. These are:

Peach Melba - the senior member with most points in open SJ classes

Crowhurst - the member with the most points gained in novice SJ classes

Canter - junior member with most points gained in all SJ classes

RFRC Shield - senior member with most points in all SJ classes

RFRC Junior Shield - junior member with most points in SJ open classes

POINTS - awarded to RFRC members only in all classes

1st highest gets

4 points,

2nd highest gets

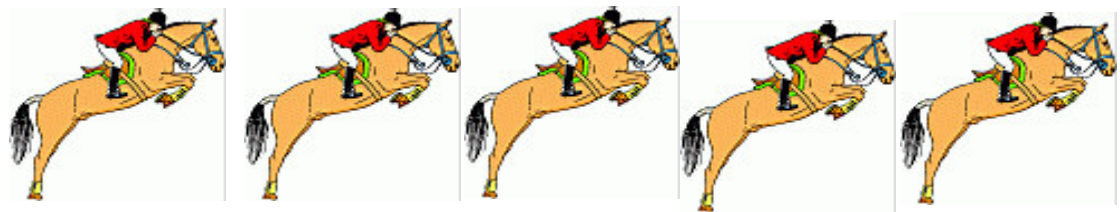
3 points,

3rd highest gets

2 points,

4th highest gets

1 point.



RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) It is a condition of entry that each competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
- 2) The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of or to any horse, rider, spectator or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 3) No entry is accepted without the correct remittance.
- 4) In case of adverse weather it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed.
- 5) Any competitor jumping any fence outside the jumping rings other than the allocated practice fence will be disqualified.
- 6) The organisers reserve the right to refuse or refund entries.
- 7) Any objection must be lodged at the secretary's box within 15 minutes of the end of the class with a deposit of £10. The panel's decision is final. If the objection is over-ruled, the deposit is not refundable.
- 8) All competitors MUST, when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN1384 or PAS015 minimum standard fitted with a three point harness. Hair must not hang below the collar. Penalty for not obeying this rule is elimination.
- 9) No galloping is allowed outside the ring(s).
- 10) Competitors eliminated or retiring must leave the course / ring at a walk and may not jump after retiring.
- 11) We advise wearing a back protector at all times when mounted at all shows and events, although this is not compulsory.
- 12) All DOGS must be kept on leads and under control at ALL TIMES unless securely left inside vehicles. Remember dogs will die if left in hot cars
- 13) In the event of cancellation by RFRFC, 80% of entry fee will be refunded.

14) Photographer attending, if you do not wish your child to be photographed, please notify the Secretary upon entry.

15) Please **DO NOT** muck out your lorry/trailer onto showground, penalty for doing so is **£10**
