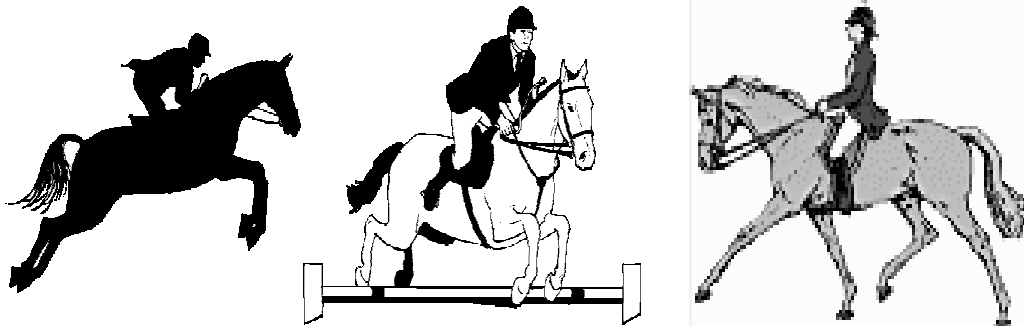

# CLASSES

## **Class 1 Show Jumping & XC Style Fences**

Fences 70cm (approx 2'3")

*Horse/Rider combination not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in any ODE or have any BE points.*

## **Class 2 Show Jumping & XC Style Fences**

Fences 75cm (approx 2'6")

*Horse/Rider combination not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in any ODE or have any BE points.*

## **Class 3 Show Jumping & XC Style Fences & BE90 Test 91 (2009)**

Fences 75cm (approx 2'6")

*Horse/Rider combination not to have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in any ODE or have any BE points.*

# **INFORMATION FOR ALL ENTRANTS**

**Class 1** will start at 10am

All phases will take place on grass.

Classes will be run in numerical order.

All fences will be knock-down obstacles.

The show jumping phase will be coloured show jumps and the XC style phase will be rustic and plain coloured fences, built as closely as possible to cross country type obstacles.

A copy of BE90 Test 91 horse trials dressage test is included with this schedule

Both jumping phases will have a time allowed applied. Every second, or part of a second, over the time will incur one penalty point.

The XC jumping phase may include corners, arrowheads, bounces and offset fences and water trays.

In case of inclement weather, it is the rider's responsibility to phone the entry secretary or check the website **[www.rfrc.org](http://www.rfrc.org)**, for cancellation notification.

## **PENALTIES**

Dressage scores will be converted to penalties.

Jumping penalties for each phase as follows:-

Knockdown / Foot in water (or on lath).....	5 penalties
1 <sup>st</sup> Disobedience.....	10 penalties
2 <sup>nd</sup> Disobedience.....	20 penalties
3 <sup>rd</sup> Disobedience.....	Elimination
Fall.....	Elimination
Error of course.....	Elimination
For every second (or part) over the time allowed.....	1 penalty

## DRESSCODE

Cross Country clothing may be worn for both jumping phases if desired.

Back protectors **MUST** be worn for the XC phase.

No watches or other timing devices permitted.

Jodhpurs or breeches; cream, white, canary or beige. **No other colour.**

Jacket with shirt and tie or stock, or XC shirt.

Gloves must be worn for the Dressage phase.

Long rubber or leather riding boots, or jodhpur boots with matching colour gaiters or chaps.

Hats must be worn when mounted, to the current BSEN1384 OR PAS015 minimum standard fitted with a 3 point harness.

Hair must not hang below collar.

## HORSE/PONY

Need not be plaited for any phase, but should be clean and tidy.

No boots or bandages permitted in the dressage phase.

BD tack only permitted in the dressage phase.

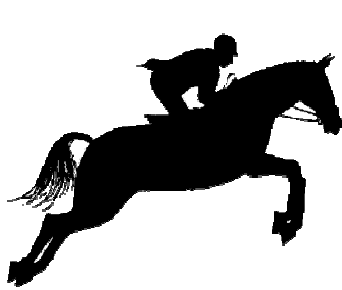

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1) It is a condition of entry that each competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
- 2) The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of, or to any, horse, rider, spectator, or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 3) No entry will be accepted without the correct remittance.
- 4) In the case of adverse weather, it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed.
- 5) Any competitor jumping any fence outside the jumping rings, other than the allocated practice fence, will be disqualified.
- 6) The organisers reserve the right to refuse or refund entries.
- 7) Any objection must be lodged at the secretary's box within 15 minutes of the end of the class with a deposit of £10. The panel's decision is final. If the objection is over-ruled, the deposit is not refundable.
- 8) All competitors **MUST**, when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN1384 OR PAS015 minimum standard fitted with a 3 point harness. Hair must not hang below the collar. Penalty for not obeying this rule is elimination.
- 9) Competitors eliminated or retiring must leave the course/ring at a walk and may not jump after retiring.
- 10) No galloping is allowed outside the ring(s).
- 11) We advise wearing a back protector at all times when mounted at all shows and events, although this is not compulsory.
- 12) All **DOGS** must be kept on leads and under control at **all times**, Unless securely left inside vehicles.  
***Remember dogs will die if left in hot cars.***
- 13) In the event of cancellation by RFRC, 80% of the entry fee will be refunded.
- 14) Photographer attending, if you do not wish your child to be Photographed, please notify the Secretary upon entry.
- 15) Please **DO NOT** muck out your lorry/trailer onto the showground, penalty for doing so is £10.
