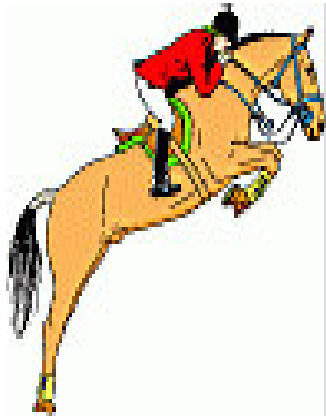

Evening Show Jumping

All classes will run as a single phase competition. This means that a timed section will be included in the first round, this should be completed in all cases unless elimination has been called.

Sunday Show Jumping

A 'jump off' round against the clock will be required following the completion of **all** first rounds, as normal. If there is insufficient time due to a high number of entries, a single phase system, as above, will be used.

NB. The organiser reserves the right to change the above jump-off methods depending on entry numbers.

Class 1	60cm (approx 1'6)	<i>May be lead</i>
Class 2	65cm (approx 2'0")	Clear Round
Class 3	70cm (approx 2'3")	
Class 4	75cm (approx 2'6")	
Class 5	75cm <i>and above</i>	Clear Round

6pm start all Thursday Shows

Class 1	65cm (approx 2'0")
Class 2	70cm (approx 2'3")
Class 3	75cm (approx 2'6")

Novice Classes are open to horse/rider combinations not to have won more than 15 RFRC show jumping points, if an RFRC member, or not to have come 1st or 2nd in **any** show jumping class if a non-member.

NB. Any horse/rider combination who is lead for the 60cm Class 1 will not be permitted to compete in any other class with or without a lead.

INFORMATION FOR ENTRANTS

DRESSCODE

Jodhpurs or breeches; cream, white, canary or beige. **No other colours.**
Jacket with shirt and tie/stock.

Long rubber/leather boots, or jodhpur boots with matching colour chaps or gaiters

Riding hats must be worn to the current BSEN1384 or PAS015 minimum standard.

MEMBER AWARDS

RFRC members will gain points towards show jumping trophies awarded at the AGM. These are:

Peach Melba - the senior member with most points in open SJ classes

Crowhurst - the member with the most points gained in novice SJ classes

Canter - junior member with most points gained in all SJ classes

RFRC Shield - senior member with most points in all SJ classes

RFRC Junior Shield - junior member with most points in SJ open classes

POINTS - awarded to RFRC members only in all classes

1st highest placed	4 points
2nd highest placed	3 points
3rd highest placed	2 points
4th highest placed	1 point

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) It is a condition of entry that each competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
- 2) The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of, or to any, horse, rider, spectator, or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 3) No entry will be accepted without the correct remittance.
- 4) In the case of adverse weather, it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed, website www.rfrc.org.uk
- 5) Any competitor jumping any fence outside the show rings, other than the allocated practice fence, will be disqualified.
- 6) The organisers reserve the right to refuse or refund entries.
- 7) Any objection must be lodged at the secretary's box within 15 minutes of the end of the class with a deposit of £10. The panel's decision is final. If the objection is over-ruled, the deposit is not refundable.
- 8) All competitors **MUST**, when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN1384 OR PAS015 minimum standard fitted with a 3 point harness. Hair must not hang below the collar. Penalty for not obeying this rule is elimination.
- 9) No galloping is permitted in show rings or warm up areas.
- 10) Competitor eliminated/retiring must leave the course/ring at a walk and may not jump after retiring.
- 11) We advise the wearing of a back protector at all times when mounted at shows, however, this is not compulsory.
- 11) All DOGS must be kept on leads and under control at all times.
- 12) In the event of cancellation by RFRC, 80% of the entry fee will be refunded.
- 13) Photographer attending, if you do not wish your child to be photographed, please notify the Secretary upon entry.
- 14) Please **DO NOT** muck out your lorry/trailer onto the showground, penalty for doing so is **£10**.
