FIELD FARM NOVICE

Class 3	Novice 24 (2010)	Section R & O
Class 4	Pick-a-Test <i>Intro A (2008), N30 (2006), E42 (2008)</i>	Section R & O

SECTION R - Restricted

Prelim - any horse/rider combination not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any dressage test, except for BD Intro Tests.

Novice - any horse/rider combination not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any novice test or above.

Horses with BD points may not compete in restricted sections.

SECTION O - Open

Prelim - Any horse with less than 49 BD points

Novice - Any horses with less than 124 BD points

Elementary - Any horses with less than 166 BD points

Intro - open to bona-fide novice riders never to have been placed in a dressage test or young horses not to have been placed in a dressage test.

Horse/rider combinations should enter either the Restricted or Open sections but not both.

Horse/Pony

Need not be plaited, but should be clean and tidy.

No boots or bandages

BD tack permitted only.

Rider

Jodhpurs or breeches - Cream, white, canary or beige.

Show jacket with shirt & tie or stock

Gloves must be worn, preferably light in colour.

Long rubber/leather riding boots or jodhpur boots with matching plain coloured chaps or gaiters

Hats must be fastened at all times when mounted.

Hair must not hang below collar.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) It is a condition of entry that each competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
- 2) The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of, or to any, horse, rider, spectator, or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 3) No entry will be accepted without the correct remittance.
- 4) In the case of adverse weather, it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed.
- 5) Any competitor jumping any fence outside the jumping rings, other than the allocated practise fence, will be disqualified.
- 6) The organisers reserve the right to refuse or refund entries.
- 7) Any objection must be lodged at the secretary's box within 15 minutes of the end of the class with a deposit of £10. The panel's decision is final. If the objection is over-ruled, the deposit is not refundable.
- 8) All competitors **MUST**, when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN1384 OR PAS015 minimum standard fitted with a 3 point harness. Hair must not hang below the collar. Penalty for not obeying this rule is elimination.
- 9) No galloping is permitted in arenas or warm up areas.
- 10) We advise the wearing of a back protector at all times when mounted at shows, however, this is not compulsory.
- 11) All **DOGS** must be kept on leads and under control at all times.
- 12) In the event of cancellation by RFRC, 80% of the entry fee will be refunded.
- 13) Photographer attending, if you do not wish your child to be photographed, please notify the Secretary upon entry.

NB A £100 penalty is imposed by Moulton College, for anybody found to have left horse dropping in the parking areas.
Please pick up your horse's droppings.
