

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. It is a condition of entry that each entry competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
2. The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of or to any horse, rider, spectator or any persons or property whatsoever.
3. No entry will be accepted without correct remittance.
4. In case of adverse weather conditions it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed.
5. Any competitor jumping any fence outside the jumping rings other than the allocated practice fence will be disqualified.
6. The organisers reserve the right to refund or refuse entries.
7. Any objection must be lodged with the secretary within 15 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £25. The panels decision is final. If the objection is upheld the deposit is refundable.
8. All competitors MUST when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN standard fitted with a three point harness.
9. No galloping outside the rings.
10. Competitors eliminated must leave the ring at walk. No remounting.
11. We advise wearing body protectors at all times when mounted at all shows and events, although this is not compulsory.
12. All DOGS must be kept on a lead and under control at ALL TIMES, unless securely left in vehicle. *Remember dogs may die if left in hot cars.*
13. In the event of cancellation, RFRC will refund 80% of entry fee.
14. No horse with more than 100 BD points may enter dressage class.
15. No refunds without producing either a Doctor or Vet certificate.
16. **PHOTOGRAPHER ATTENDING** – if you do not wish your child to be photographed please inform secretary upon entry.
17. Riders age as on 1st January.

Please DO NOT muck out your lorry or trailer onto the showground.

The penalty for doing so is £10

RING 1 – SHOWING

(Commencing at 9.15am)

Class 1. Best Turned Out – Open

Class 2. *Equifest* Show Pony Lead Rein – Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 yrs or over not exceeding 122 cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 3. *Equifest* Show Pony First Ridden – First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 yrs or over not exceeding 122 cms. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 4. *Equifest* Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein – Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A & B. Mare or gelding, 4 yrs or over not exceeding 122 cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only. Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 5. *Equifest* Mountain & Moorland First Ridden – Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A & B. Mare or gelding, 4 yrs or over not exceeding 128 cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Rosettes to all entrants.

CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st & 2nd prize-winners in classes 1-5. Champion & Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship.

Class 6. Pony Club Pony. Ponies not to exceed 14.2 hh. *To be judged on suitability as a p.c. pony, Competitors will be required to jump a small fence and give an individual show. Not to be judged on conformation.*

Class 7. *Equifest* Open Ridden Show Pony – mare or gelding, 4 yrs old and over, not exceeding 148 cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

- Whilst effort will be made to accommodate exhibitors competing in more than one ring please make entries sensibly as NO REFUNDS will be made for entries where classes slash
- Please leave adequate time to prepare for your class
- *The two highest placed exhibits in classes 2 -5,7-9,13,21-24, 28, 33-34 will qualify for Equifest.*

Rosettes 1st to 6th in all classes except 2–5 and 15-20 where rosettes will be awarded to every competitor.

RING 5 - SHOW JUMPING

(Promptly at 10.00am)

Class 35. 2'0" Open

Class 36. 2' 3" Open

Class 37. 2'6" Open

Class 38. 2'9" Open

Class 39. 3'3" Open

Classes 35 – 39 will run as a 2-phase competition, i.e. Jump the course and, if clear, continue on to do a timed jump-off course.

Classes will be split between horses and ponies if sufficient entries.

MEMBERS CHAMPIONSHIP

RFRC members in showing classes should wear an armband. The highest placed member in each class will be awarded a special rosette. Winners of these rosettes are eligible for the Members Championship.

The Members Champion will be awarded the Coombewood Trophy at the AGM.

The Members Champion and Reserve will receive a Sash and be eligible for the Supreme of Show Championship

SUPREME OF SHOW CHAMPIONSHIP

The Supreme of Show Championship is open to all Champions and Reserves. To be held in Ring 2 at the end of the day.

Class 8. . *Equifest* Open Ridden Show Hunter Pony – mare or gelding, 4 yrs old and over, not exceeding 153 cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 9. *Equifest* Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Pony – Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A , B, C & D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 yrs or over. Riders any age.

CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st & 2nd prize-winners in classes 6-9. Champion & Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship.

RING 2 – SHOWING

(Commencing at 9.15am)

Class 10. Youngstock. In-Hand. Animals 1, 2, 3 years old.

Class 11. Best Condition. In-Hand. Open.

Class 12. Veteran. In-Hand. Animals 15 years or over.

Class 13. *Equifest* Open Mountain & Moorland Pony In Hand. – Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A , B, C & D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding.

Class 14. Coloured horse/pony. In-Hand. Piebald & Skewbald, Spotted, Roan, Dun or Palomino.

CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st and 2nd prize-winners in Classes 10-14. Champion and Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship.

RING 2 – SHOWING FUN CLASSES

(To follow on) Open to in-hand competitors only. Rosettes to all entrants.

Class 15. Best Mane.

Class 16. Best Tail.

Class 17. Prettiest Mare.

Class 18. Handsomest Gelding.

Class 19. Thelwell Pony.

Class 20. Horse/Pony the Judge would most like to take home.

RING 3 – SHOWING

(Commencing at 9.15am)

Class 21. *Equifest* Open Riding Horses, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age.

Class 22. *Equifest* Open Ridden Hunter. Mare or gelding, 4 years and over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

Class 23. *Equifest* Open Ridden Cob. Mare or gelding, 4 years and over, exceeding 155cms. Riders any age.

Class 24. *Equifest* Open Show Hack, mare or gelding, 4 years and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160 cms. Riders any age.

CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st & 2nd prize-winners for Classes 21-24. Championship and Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship

Class 25. Competition Horse/Pony. Horse/Pony 4yrs old and over. Rider to be an appropriate size for the animal which they ride. *Riders will enter the ring individually and perform an individual show to include the following movements, Halt, Walk on a long rein, 3 loop trot serpentine, extended trot on the diagonal, 3 loop canter serpentine with change of lead, extended canter on the diagonal. Individual show not to exceed 2 minutes.*

Class 26.. Ridden Veteran. Horse/Pony 18 years and over.

Class 27. Ridden Coloured. Skewbald, Piebald, Spotted, Roan, Dun, Palomino etc.

Class 28. *Equifest* Open Ridden Piebald/Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age.

CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st & 2nd prize-winners for Classes 25-28. Championship and Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship

RING 4 – WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

(Commencing at 9.15am)

Class 29. Cradle Stakes. Ponies not to exceed 12.hh. Rider 10 years and under. Fences not to exceed 1' 3".

Class 30. Nursery Stakes. Ponies not to exceed 13hh. Rider 12 yrs and under. Fences not to exceed 1.9".

Class 31. Working Hunter Pony. Ponies not to exceed 15.hh. Rider to be an appropriate size for the animal which they ride. Fences not to exceed 2' 3".

Class 32. Working Hunter. Horses exceeding 15 hh. Riders any age. Fences not to exceed 2' 9".

CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st & 2nd Prize Winners for Classes 29 -32. Championship and Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship.

Class 33. *Equifest* Working Hunter Pony – (Mixed Height.) mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153 cms. Riders must be the correct age for the animal they ride.

Class 34. *Eqifest* Mountain & Moorland Working Hunter Ponies – (Mixed Height) Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highlands, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A , B, C & D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 yrs or over. Riders any age.

CHAMPIONSHIP Open to 1st & 2nd Prize Winners for Classes 33 & 34. Championship and Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship
