1. It is a condition of entry that each competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
2. The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of or to any horse, rider, spectator or any other persons or property whatsoever.
3. No entry is accepted without the correct remittance.
4. In case of adverse weather, it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed.
5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse or refund entries.
6. All competitors **MUST**, when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN1384 minimum standard.
7. We advise wearing a back protector.
8. Children 14 years or under must be accompanied by an adult.
9. Horses should be over the age of 4 years.
10. No stallions permitted.
11. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is fit enough for the ride, well shod and up to date with flu vaccinations.
12. High visibility wear is recommended as some road work will be required.
