DRESSAGE - *Classes will start at 10am*

Class 1	Preliminary 14 (2006)	Section R & O
Class 2*	Preliminary 18 (2002)	Section R & O
Class 3	Novice 24 (2010)	Section R & O
Class 4*	Novice 27 (2007)	Section R & O
Class 5*	Elementary 44 (2002)	Open

***Class 2 & 4** are championship classes and open to qualified RFRC members only.

***Class 5** championship class but also open to any other rider.

You may enter a restricted or open section, but **not** both on the same horse.

Section R – Restricted to horse & rider combinations not to have won more than 15 RFRC dressage points, or not to have come 1st in **any** dressage test if a non-member. Horses with BD points are **not** permitted to compete in this section.

Section O – Open to any horse with less than 49 BD points at Prelim level, 124 BD points at Novice level and less than 199 BD points at Elementary level.

Need not be plaited, but should be clean and tidy.

No boots or bandages

British Dressage approved tack permitted only.

DRESSAGE QUALIFICATION

- Open to RFRC members **only**.
- Qualify for Preliminary and Novice at either Restricted or Open level, or Elementary Level.
- Member scores of 58% or over will qualify.
- You **must** enter the championship class at the highest level that you have qualified.
- Rosettes 1st – 10th plus winner sashes in all championship classes.

SHOW JUMPING – No qualification required for Championship Classes, however, RFRC members eligible **only**.

Class 1	70cm (approx 2'3")	Open to all
Class 2	Novice Championship Round 1 70cm (approx 2'3") Round 2 75cm (approx 2'6") <i>Round 2 to include a timed section</i>	RFRC Members Only
Class 3	85cm (approx 2'9")	Open to all
Class 4	Open Championship Round 1 85cm (2'9" approx) Round 2 95cm (3'0" approx) <i>Round 2 to include a timed section</i>	RFRC Members Only

Championship Classes (2 & 4)

Championship classes require the completion of 2 show jumping rounds. The first round is not timed, however, if eliminated in this round the rider will not be eligible to complete the second round. The second round will include a timed section, specified on the day.

The winner of the class will be the best first round and the best second round with the fastest time.

DRESS CODE FOR DRESSAGE & SHOW JUMPING

Jodhpurs or breeches – cream, white, canary or beige,
NO OTHER COLOURS

Jacket with a shirt and tie or stock.

Gloves must be worn for dressage classes, preferably light in colour.
Long rubber or leather riding boots, or jodhpur boots with matching coloured gaiters or chaps.

Hats must be fastened at all times whilst mounted.

Hair must not hang below collar.
