All ridden show horses and ponies should be 4 years or over.

RING 1 – Ridden Showing *10am start.*

- Class 1 Best Turned Out Horse/Pony.** Open.
- Class 2 Lead Rein.** Leading rein pony not exceeding 122cms. Riders should be 8yrs and under. Snaffle Bridles must be used and lead rein should be attached to the noseband only.
- Class 3 First Ridden.** Ponies not exceeding 122cms. Riders should be 10yrs and under. Suitable bridle should be used.
- Class 4 Ridden Pony.** Any breed, not to exceed 14.2hh
- Class 5 Ridden Horse.** Any breed, 14.3hh or over.
- Class 6 Ridden Veteran Horse/Pony.** Any breed 15yrs or over.
- Class 7 Ridden Mountain & Moorland.** Native breeds only. Class may be split into small/large breeds if sufficient entries.
- Class 8 Ridden Coloured Horse/Pony.** Open to Piebald, Skewbald, Spotted, Roan, Dun or Palomino horses or ponies.

Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize-winners in Classes 1-8.
Champion and Reserve go forward to Supreme Championship.

RING 2 – IN-HAND SHOWING *10am start.*

- Class 9 Open Young Stock.** 3 years and under. Any height or breed.
- Class 10 Best Condition.** Horse or pony any breed, in-hand.
- Class 11 In-Hand Veteran.** 15 years or over, any height or breed.
- Class 12 In-Hand Mountain & Moorland.** Native breeds, any height.
Class may be split if sufficient entries.
- Class 13 In-Hand Coloured.** Open to Piebald, Skewbald, Spotted, Roan, Dun, or Palomino horses or ponies.

Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize-winners in Classes 9-13.
Champion and Reserve go forward to Supreme Championship

Open to in-hand competitors only, except Class 21; this may be ridden.

Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize-winners in Classes 15-20.
Champion and Reserve go forward to Supreme Championship

RING 3 – RIDING CLUB & WORKING HUNTER 10.30am start.

The Working Hunter Course will be available for clear rounds when all classes are completed.

Class 21 Riding/Pony Club Pony. Ponies not to exceed 14.2hh. Judged for suitability as a RC/PC pony. Competitors will be required to jump a small fence and give an individual show. Riders any age.

Class 22 Riding/Pony Club Horse. Horses over 14.2hh. Judged for suitability as a RC/PC horse. Competitors will be required to jump a small fence and give an individual show. Riders any age.

Class 23 Cradle Stakes. Ponies not to exceed 12.2hh. Rider 10 years or under. Fences not to exceed 1'3". May be lead.

Class 24 Nursery Stakes. Ponies not to exceed 13.2hh. Rider 12 years or under. Fences not to exceed 1'9".

Class 25 Working Hunter Pony. Ponies not to exceed 15hh. Riders any age. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

Class 26 Working Hunter. Horses exceeding 15hh. Riders any age. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

Championship. Open to 1st and 2nd prize-winners in Classes 21-26.
Champion and Reserve go forward to Supreme Championship.

Supreme Championship. To be held at the end of the day.
Open to Champions and Reserves from all Championship Classes.

RING 5 – CLEAR ROUND SHOW JUMPING

Jumping heights will commence at 55cm and may be lead. Fence heights will be raised at intervals throughout the day. Rosettes to all Clear Rounds.

- No entries will be accepted without the full entry fee
- Whilst every effort will be made to accommodate competitors due in more than one ring, please make entries sensible as **no refunds** will be made entries where classes clash.
- Please leave adequate time to prepare for your class.

RFRC Points Awarded to RFRC members only in all classes except classes 15-20.

1st highest	4 points
2nd highest	3 points
3rd highest	2 points
4th highest	1 point

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. It is a condition of entry that each entry competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
2. The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of or to any horse, rider, spectator or any persons or property whatsoever.
3. No entry will be accepted without correct remittance.
4. In case of adverse weather conditions it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed.
5. Any competitor jumping any fence outside the jumping rings other than the allocated practice fence will be disqualified.
6. The organisers reserve the right to refund or refuse entries.
7. Any objection must be lodged with the secretary within 15 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £25. The panel's decision is final. If the objection is upheld the deposit is refundable.
8. All competitors **MUST** when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN1384 OR PAS015 minimum standard, fitted with a three point harness. Hair must not hang below the collar. Penalty for not obeying this rule is elimination.
9. No galloping outside the rings.
10. Competitors eliminated must leave the ring at walk. No remounting.
11. We advise wearing body protectors at all times when mounted at all shows and events, although this is not compulsory.
12. All DOGS must be kept on a lead and under control at ALL TIMES, unless securely left in vehicle. *Remember dogs may die if left in hot cars.*
13. In the event of cancellation, RFRC will refund 80% of entry fee.
14. No horse with more than 100 BD points may enter dressage class.
15. No refunds without producing either a Doctor or Vet certificate.
16. **PHOTOGRAPHER ATTENDING** – if you do not wish your child to be photographed please inform secretary upon entry.

Please DO NOT muck out your lorry or trailer onto the Showground. The penalty for doing so is £10
