Novice restricted to any horse/rider combination not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any novice test or above.

Horses with BD points may not compete in restricted sections.

Section O – Open

Any other horse/rider combination

Horse/rider combinations can enter either Restricted or Open sections but not both.

DRESS CODE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED

Horse/Pony

Need not be plaited, but should be clean and tidy.

No boots or bandages

BD tack permitted only.

Rider

Jodhpurs or breeches - Cream, white, canary or beige

NO OTHER COLOURS

Show jacket with shirt & tie or stock, or RFRC sweatshirt.

Gloves must be worn, preferably dark in colour.

Long rubber/leather riding boots or jodhpur boots with matching plain coloured chaps or gaiters

Hats must be fastened at all times when mounted.

Hair must not hang below collar.

***ROYAL WINDSOR HORSE SHOW – Riding Test Qualifier – (Class 5)**

Class 5 is the 1st round qualifier for the Royal Windsor Horse Show Riding Test Championships to be held in May 2010. You do not need to be a member of British Riding Clubs to qualify in the 1st round, however, you will need to join a Riding Club in order to compete in round 2.

One junior and one senior rider will qualify in each class to go forward to the second round at the appropriate Area Qualifier, each Riding Club will advise members of the Area Qualifier venue. Horse and rider combinations which have already qualified may not qualify twice. In the event of this happening, qualification will pass to the next placed combination. Senior riders are those aged 18 or over on 1st January 2010, any rider who does not meet this criteria will be deemed as a Junior rider.

Competitors for the qualifier will need to download an entry form from www.rwhs.co.uk or www.britishridingclubs.org.uk. Riders who qualify for Round 2 will be given entry forms by the organiser of the show. Only one horse and rider combination will qualify at Round 2 for the next round held at the Royal Windsor Horse Show (RWHS). There will be 4 phases for the Riding Test Competition;

- Club Qualifiers (*as per this schedule*)
- Area Qualifier
- RWHS Final
- RWHS Championships

BRC Riding Tests

The object of a riding test is to assess the rider's technique as a rider and that the influence of their aids are beneficial for the horse's way of going. They are performed in a 20 x 40 area, marked out as for a dressage test. The judges' observations will relate specifically to the rider as a priority, secondly to the effects on the training of the horse. BRC Riding Tests can be purchase via www.britishridingclubs.org.uk

ELIGIBILITY RULES

Equine Flu Vaccinations

Horses and ponies do not need to comply with BRC Equine Flu Vac requirements for Round 1. However, those who qualify for Round 2 must have at least the first Primary injection, at least 7 days prior to that show.

Horses & Ponies

A maximum of 0 – 60 BD points

Riders

Riders are not able to compete if they hold any of the following qualifications; FBHS, BHSI, BHSII, BHSI, PC A TEST if taken within the last 10 years.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) It is a condition of entry that each competitor has read, understood and agreed to abide by these rules.
- 2) The organisers and all persons connected with the event, accept no liability for any accident, damage, illness or loss of, or to, any horse, rider, spectator or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 3) No entry is accepted without the correct remittance.
- 4) In case of adverse weather it is the responsibility of the entrant to enquire if the event is postponed.
- 5) The organisers reserve the right to refuse or refund entries.
- 6) Any objection must be lodged at the secretary's box within 15 minutes of the end of the class with a deposit of £10. The panel's decision is final. If the objection is over-ruled, the deposit is not refundable.
- 7) All competitors MUST, when mounted, wear riding hats to the current BSEN1384 minimum standard fitted with a three point harness. Penalty for not obeying this rule is elimination. Hair must not hang below collar.
- 8) No galloping is allowed outside the ring(s).
- 9) We advise wearing a back protector to Level 3 at all times when mounted at all shows and events, although this is not compulsory.
- 10) All DOGS must be kept on a lead and under control at ALL TIMES unless securely left inside vehicles. Remember dogs will die if left in hot cars
- 11) In the event of cancellation by RFRC, 80% of entry fee will be refunded.
- 12) No refunds without producing either Doctor or Vet Certificate.
- 13) Photographer Attending – if you do not wish your child to be photographed, please notify Secretary upon Entry.
